



Call for Nominations Michael A. Little Early Career Award

The Michael A. Little Early Career Award recognizes a member of the Human Biology Association, in the early years of her or his career, for a significant contribution to the field of human biology and the promise of future significant contributions. The award is open to all HBA Fellows with a PhD, and is *not* limited to those in academic employment. Criteria for the award are (1) the recipient shall be identified for a specific contribution or set of contributions to the field; (2) the nominators deem high the likelihood of continuing, significant contributions to the field; (3) the recipient has received her/his PhD within 8 years prior to the nomination.

Nominations for the Little Award must be made on the form below and include a **current curriculum vitae** of the nominee and **two letters of support** from HBA Fellows. The letters must provide specific documentation of the nominee's contributions to the field, including details of important papers, funding, significant innovations, and/or contributions to policy and/or practice, as well as a detailed assessment of potential future contributions. All materials should be sent as a single PDF to: Susan Tanner, Chair Nominations and Election Committee, stanner1@uga.edu. The winner will be notified by February 15, 2019 and will be honored at the 2019 Annual Meeting Awards Luncheon, with a plaque and an award of \$1000.

The deadline for nominations is October 15, 2018 – the deadline is firm.
